#### Psalm 92:1-4, 12-15

<sup>1</sup>It is good to give thanks to the LORD, to sing praises to your name, O Most High;

<sup>2</sup>to declare your steadfast love in the morning, and your faithfulness by night,

<sup>3</sup>to the music of the lute and the harp, to the melody of the lyre.

<sup>4</sup>For you, O LORD, have made me glad by your work; at the works of your hands I sing for joy.

<sup>12</sup>The righteous flourish like the palm tree, and grow like a cedar in Lebanon.

<sup>13</sup>They are planted in the house of the LORD; they flourish in the courts of our God.

14In old age they still produce fruit; they are always green and full of sap,

<sup>15</sup>showing that the LORD is upright; he is my rock, and there is no unright-eousness in him.



The mustard seed becomes a great shrub that shelters the birds, recalling ancient images of the tree of life. We'd expect a cedar or a sequoia, but Jesus finds the power of God better imaged in a tiny, no-account seed. It's not the way we expect divine activity to look. Yet the tree of life is here, in the cross and around which we gather, the tree into which we are grafted through baptism, the true vine that nourishes us with its fruit in the cup we share. It may not appear all that impressive, but while nobody's looking it grows with a power beyond our understanding.
