Driving Away Hunger-MEFS Mobile Outreach

Driving Away Hunger is designed to reduce transportation and mobility issues associated with food access in our communities. The Mobile Outreach vehicle is stocked with shelf-stable pantry items, fresh produce, frozen proteins, dairy, grains, and bakery treats. <u>STOP & SHOP THE BUS at no cost to you!</u> All sites are open to the public!

Orders must be placed prior to delivery dates and are prepacked during the winter months. A limited number of walk-up portions will be available at each delivery site. The staff will accommodate anyone not able to safely enter the vehicle for shopping. The staff are not permitted to carry food inside a residence. Full grocery distributions are available once (1X) per month, per household. One visit per week is allowed across all sites.

LEFSE RECIPE

Potato Preparation

Cook 5 lb. of potatoes (Idaho Russets are best)

When cooked, mash and rice. While the potatoes are hot add:

10 T. of melted butter

4 T. half & half

Cool overnight in the refrigerator.

Day of Rolling

When ready to bake add:

2 tsp. of sugar

3 cups (scant) flour

Salt to taste

Mix and roll. Makes approximately 32 balls.

Call to Order:

• The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by President Ron Foust followed by an opening prayer led by Pastor Molly.

Council Business:

- A **motion** was made by Cathy Houg and seconded by Mitch Overbye to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried.
- In the past month, Pastor Molly attended the Youth Task Force event at St. Peter Lutheran Church. Confirmation class is ongoing. The premarital sessions have been completed. She has been working on the liturgy for a Thanksgiving/Christ the King Sunday on November 24, 2024.

Old Business:

- A motion was made by Pete Hallberg and seconded by Peg Wick to have the Finance Board proceed with
 procuring a debit card for the church through First Community Bank. Tamie Foust will manage the card.
 Motion carried.
- The updated Church Council Job Descriptions will be sent out to Council members to review for acceptance at the December Council meeting.

New Business:

- A motion was made by Jill Duncan and seconded by Pete Hallberg to set Pastor Molly's housing allowance for the 2025 budget at \$27,335.50. Motion carried.
- A **motion** was made by Mitch Overbye and seconded by Bryon Weisenburger to give \$50.00 in Prairie Bucks to each of the five church employees as a Christmas gift. Motion carried.
- The Finance board will begin year-end consultations and salary discussions for budget purposes.
- A **motion** was made by Bryon Weisenburger and seconded by Stacy Meyer to set the Congregational Annual Meeting for Sunday, January 26, 2025, following worship with a potluck after the meeting. Motion carried.
- Jeff and Peggy Wick summarized the Equipping Congregation meeting held on Nov. 2, 2024, in New London.

Secretary Minutes:

A motion was made by Ron Foust and seconded by Mitch Overbye to accept October's secretary's report.
 Motion carried.

Treasurer Reports:

- A **motion** was made by Stacy Meyer and seconded by Peg Wick to zero out the Bergen Monument Fund and put those monies into the Cemetery fund. Motion carried.
- A **motion** was made by Pete Hallberg and seconded by Cathy Houg to accept October's treasurer's report. Motion carried.

Financial Secretary Report:

• A **motion** was made by Cathy Houg and seconded by Jill Duncan to accept October's financial secretary's report. Motion carried.

Reports:

- **Education Board:** Ten Commandment and Lord's Prayer Milestones are coming up. A Birthday for Jesus will be held in December.
- **Finance Board:** The budget discussions have begun. They will talk to the congregation for ideas to replace the janitor who retires at the end of the year.
- **Trustees:** The bathroom updates have been completed. A new faucet is being installed in the basement furnace room. Litzau Snow Removal has been contracted to remove snow this season at \$57/time. The thermostats have been reset and batteries replaced. They continue looking at quotes for redoing the parking lot.

Communications:


- Endowment grant submissions are due the end of November.

- Annual Meeting End-of-the-Year Reports are due to Tamie Foust by December 15, 2024. Financial Reports are due by January 10, 2025. These include Pr. Molly, Pres., Ed., Fin., Trustee, Treasurer, and the 2025 Budget.
- Janitor Lori Dolezal is retiring at the end of 2024. The Council is looking for replacement recommendations.
 The meeting closed with Round Table Prayers and the Lord's Prayer at 7:30 p.m.
